### Dear School Leader,

Supporting and developing Newly Qualified Teachers in their first year of teaching is hugely important. We know you will want the very best for your colleagues as they take up their new role. This year in particular we will support schools to address the atypical cohort and their relative lack of experience in the classroom. Our programme takes this into account in each of the sessions and triad experiences. Our Primary NQT Training Programme has been developed to reinforce key subject knowledge areas, as well as provide informal links and support throughout the year. We aim to help you develop highly skilled reflective practitioners for the future.

The programme provides NQTs with an opportunity to regularly reflect on their practice, with peers, and to integrate further ideas and approaches to develop their teaching. Each workshop has a specific theme as well as providing focused discussion about progress and support.

The sessions will be led by senior staff within Hackney Learning Trust who come with a wealth of teaching and leadership experience. Some sessions may need to move to an on-line platform due to health and safety.

We welcome interest from schools who may wish to purchase individual elements of the programme from the NQT training package. We look forward to working with you on this and other aspects of professional development.

The NQT Programme costs £995, which includes the cost of the Appropriate Body.
