Hackney Education has refreshed its approach to school to school support creating a programme of Professional Learning Exchanges. Our new model promotes growth through collaborative approaches that respond to changing needs, which also draw on the innovations, excellence and strengths in our borough.

Professional Learning Exchanges, Walkabouts, designed for two distinct leadership groups. One; Headteachers, Principals, Deputy Heads and the other; Heads/Directors of Sixth Form (or equivalent). Participants have the opportunity to visit one another's settings and, equally, to host visits focused on agreed themes or aspects.

Professional Learning Exchange Talkabouts, describe the new look to our subject network forums. In the Spring term 2025, Pre and Post-16 subjects will be strategically grouped together whilst some, such as core subjects, will remain unchanged.

Leaders from these areas will spend mornings or afternoons engaging in collaborative learning experiences that focus on best practices, innovative teaching strategies, and the latest educational research.
