La Poli (The police)

This series of video clips is suitable for year 7 (and year 5 and 6 pupils who have studied Spanish for 3 or 4 years). It consists of 10 amusing video clips where the police try to find a band of robbers and we see the robbers planning the robbery. There are lots of visual clues, plus reinforcement of vocabulary all spoken at a slow pace. There are suggested activities and things to do to follow up.
