Display it!

Make a poster about it to put up at your window to share with your neighbours.



Test it!

Challenge your family to ask you 10 questions on the topic – will you be able to answer them in no more than 2 minutes?

Quiz it!

Create some true/false questions to test your family on your topic.

What is it!

An alien has landed – tell them everything you know about it!



Present it or Code it!

Use IT to present about it, code it or create a website for it, make a video about it.

Talk it!

Prepare a 5/10-minute speech for your family, book a time when they can sit down and listen properly with a nice cup of tea!

Publish it!

Make a book about it – your books could have lift the flaps etc.! It could be for a younger sibling and it could be information or instructions!

Read about it!

Read a book, a website, magazine etc. about it.



Take a topic that you...

Either know lots about

Or want to learn about

Then can you ...

Good evening and welcome it!

Put together a TV show about your topic. Pretend to be a presenter, interview someone, show pictures.

Video it if you can and edit it. Send it to a relative.

Your topic could be anything!
A person, a place, toys, games,
a sport, food, a hobby, music,
fashion, a subject etc.



Play it!

Make up a board game that uses your new knowledge- use a dice, counters etc.

Create it!

Paint it, draw it, print it, model it out of playdough!



Sing it!

Make a song/Rap about it.



Build it!

Can you build a model linked to it? You could use junk modelling, Lego etc.



Act it!

Write / act out a play about it – include parts for your family!

Make someone's day with it!

Share what you have been doing with someone not in your house. Send an email / make a phone call/ FaceTime. Great for cheering up people you can't see at the moment.
